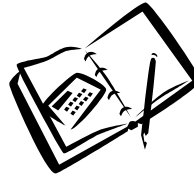

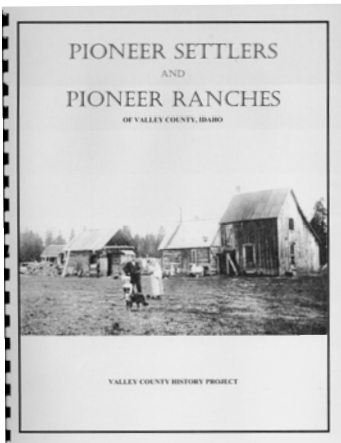

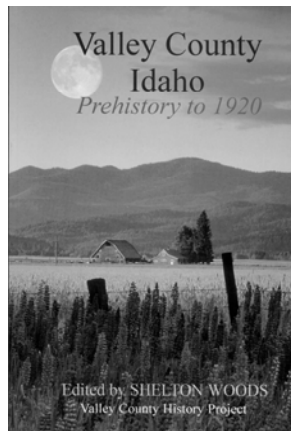
## Valley County History Project

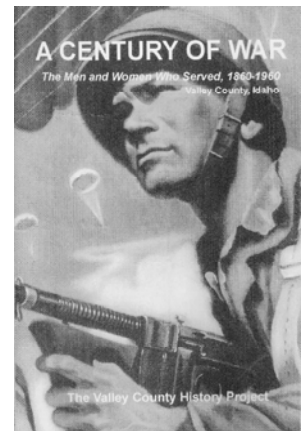
