Hours: Thurs-Sat 11-5, Sun 12-4

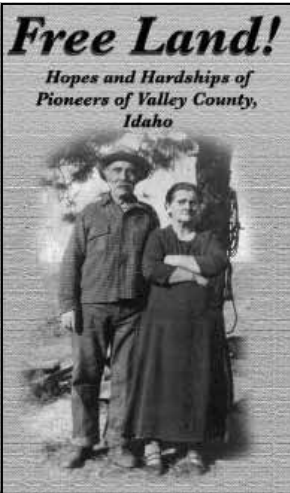
